The Master of Science in Healthcare Administration (MS) offers students the opportunity to pursue personal and professional enhancement. The degree is focused on building management, administrative and policy capacity for the next generation of health sector leaders. The MS degree prepares students for positions that require advanced management and strategic ability, policy knowledge and skills, and exceptional analytical and evaluation capacity. The key competency areas focus on the unique needs and complexities of a dynamic health care system.

PROGRAM STRUCTURE

The Master of Science in Healthcare Administration consists of approximately 360 hours of material and delivered over an 18 months period with a flexible program structure. All course material is delivered through the innovative American Vision University Canvas platform. The program has 12 courses, each course is 4 credits, the student may need 48 credits to complete the program. There are 4 terms in a year, and each term is 10 weeks long. Each term the student may register for 2 courses.
